Testing Information

Zika testing is a Medicaid and CHIP benefit. Medicaid providers are recommended to refer to the DSHS Zika testing guidelines available on TexasZika.org to determine if Zika testing is appropriate for your clients. Per the Texas Medicaid Provider Procedures Manual (TMPPM), Zika virus testing may be billed using procedure codes 86794 and 87662.
