Texas Health and Human Services (HHS) is finalizing the incentive component (also known as the "Hospital Quality Award Program") of the hospital quality-based Potentially Preventable Readmissions (PPR) & Potentially Preventable Complications (PPC) program for state fiscal year (SFY) 2016. This year's incentive component, the third installment of the Hospital Quality Award Program, uses SFY 2016 performance data to make SFY 2018 award payments. Once finalized, HHS will post the recipient hospitals and respective award amounts on the webpage (listed below), and an email will be sent to all stakeholders. The estimated timeline for the incentive payments is by the end of December 2017.
