* Notes: This quality award program for identified safety-net hospitals was funded by the Texas Legislature via H.B. 1, 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, Article II, Special Provisions Sec. 59 (B), Contingency for HB 7 and Safety-Net Hospitals.

Awards were earned for high performance on the Potentially Preventable Complications (PPC) and / or Potentially Preventable Readmissions (PPR) quality metrics. Award amounts are paid via two mechanisms, based upon the respective proportion of the hospital's billing source for the reporting period's utilization. Fee-for-service (FFS)-based awards are paid directly from The Texas Medicaid & Healthcare Partnership (TMHP) to the recipient hospital, while managed care organization (MCO)-based awards are paid directly from the hospital's contracted MCOs, per guidance from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). For example, if a hospital's billing is 20% FFS and 80% MCO, and it earned an award of \$100, \$20 would be paid via FFS and \$80 would be paid via MCOs, although final MCO payments will vary slightly from the calculated award amounts due to: a) rounding in the calculation of managed care capitation rates to incorporate these payments; b) MCOs will retain 1.75% of the award amount to cover their premium tax expense related to these pass-through payments for this program. Both FFS and MCO amounts listed here are the final amounts hospitals receive.
