Good afternoon--The Health and Human Services (HHS) congratulates hospitals who received a safety-net hospital quality award!

These 35 hospitals exemplified outstanding performance for the state fiscal year (SFY) 2016 reporting period in regards to the hospital quality-based potentially preventable readmissions and potentially preventable complications program.

As you are aware, the incentive component is paid out in two ways: in fee-for-service (FFS) via the claims administrator, and in managed care via Managed Care Organizations (MCOs).

HHS is working with the Centers of Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) on a revised and approved methodology to push out incentive payments in managed care. In the meantime, the HHS has determined that it will push out the FFS incentive payments for the SFY 2016 reporting period.
