<p><b>Licensed Child Care Home</b></p>	<p>The operation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• provides regular care in the permit holder’s own home;</li> <li>• serves children whose ages range from birth through age 13;</li> <li>• provides care fewer than 24 hours per day, but at least two hours a day, three or more days a week; and</li> <li>• cares for no more than 12 children total, including children related to the caregiver.</li> </ul> <p><b>Permit type: License</b></p>	<p><a href="#">TAC Chapter 747</a></p>	<p>Information on how to <a href="#">Become a Child Care Home Provider</a></p>
<p><b>Registered Child Care Home</b></p>	<p>The operation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• provides regular care in the permit holder’s own home;</li> <li>• serves children whose ages range from birth through age 13;</li> <li>• provides care for at least four hours a day, three or more days a week, and for more than three consecutive weeks;</li> <li>• provides care to no more than six children who are unrelated to the caregiver;</li> <li>• provides after-school care to no more than six additional elementary school children; and</li> <li>• cares for no more than 12 children, total, including children related to the caregiver.</li> </ul> <p><b>Permit type: Registration</b></p>	<p><a href="#">TAC Chapter 747</a></p>	<p>Information on how to <a href="#">Become a Child Care Home Provider</a></p>
<p><b>Listed Family Home</b></p>	<p>The operation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• provides regular care in the caregiver’s own home, for compensation;</li> <li>• serves children whose ages range from birth through age 13;</li> <li>• provides care for at least four hours a day, three or more days a week, and for more than three consecutive weeks; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• cares for no more than three unrelated children; and</li> </ul> </li> <li>• cares for no more than 12 children, total, including children who are related to the caregiver.</li> </ul> <p><b>Permit type: Listing</b></p>	<p>Currently no minimum standards; however, new rules are being drafted as a result of the 86<sup>th</sup> legislative session.</p>	<p>Information on how to <a href="#">Become a Child Care Home Provider</a></p>
