

How to Apply to Be a Medicaid Waiver Program Contractor

Our process for applying has changed. Please follow our instructions below to ensure your application is reviewed.

What do I need to do to apply?

- 1. You must be enrolled in Texas Medicaid. If you're not enrolled before you apply, your application will be denied. Enroll through the Texas Medicaid & Healthcare Partnership (TMHP) Provider Enrollment Management System (PEMS). To learn more or apply, visit:

- 2. You must complete the Provider Applicant Competency training (PAT) exam with a passing score of 85% or above. After you've completed the PAT, download the certificate showing your passing score.

Any application submitted without a certification showing completion of the PAT with a passing score will not be accepted.

- Do not apply without a completed PAT exam.
- Do not apply with a failing PAT exam score.
- If you fail the PAT exam, you can retake the exam after a period of six months. You are only allowed one attempt every six months.

3. **Fill out <u>Form 5873</u>**. This application is only available online. If you need help, we have <u>resources on our website</u>, including instructions on how to download and fill out forms. **Include your PAT exam certificate with your application packet.**

4. **Correct any errors found on your application.** A contract manager will review your application and identify any errors or deficiencies. If any are found, you'll receive a suspense letter and will be given **30 days** to correct and resubmit documents.

Are there any licenses I need for my application?

The following contract types require a Home & Community Support Services Agencies (HCSSA) License:

- Hospice.
- Community Living Assistance and Support Services (CLASS-continued family services)
- CLASS-support family services
- CLASS-direct service agency
- Deaf Blind Multiple Disabilities (DBMD)

If you need an HCSSA license, you can call the Licensing and Certification Unit at 512-438-2630. Or you can <u>visit our web page</u>.

You don't need an HCSSA license to apply for or get a contract to provide Home and Community-based Services (HCS) and Texas Home Living (TxHmL) services.

My application was denied. Can I reapply?

Yes, but you must retake the PAT and submit a new application after a period of six months from the previous attempt. **DO NOT** submit a copy of the previously denied application.



You can avoid having your application denied by:

- Making sure you provide all the required forms.
- Responding to requests for application corrections by the due date (within 30 calendar days of receiving a suspense letter).
