**Information and Instructions
for Completion of Affidavit
(concerning payment of child support)**

This affidavit is the temporary form to be used by each bidder for a state contract or applicant for a state-funded loan or grant as required by the Texas Family Code, Section 14.52 (Senate Bill Number 84, enacted by the 73rd Texas Legislature in Regular Session). CAUTION: False Disclosures on This Affidavit Constitute a Criminal Offense Under the Laws of the State of Texas.

Submission of this affidavit is required for each individual submitting a bid or entering into a contract with the state or receiving a state-funded grant or loan. Submission of this affidavit is also required from each sole proprietor, partner, majority shareholder or substantial owner of an entity submitting a bid on a state contract. (A substantial owner for purposes of determining the persons required to submit this affidavit shall mean a person who owns ten percent or more of the equitable interest in the entity submitting the bid.) All required affidavits must be submitted as a part of each bid for a state contract or application for a state-funded grant or loan.

Note: If you have completed this affidavit for any state agency in the state of Texas within the past year and there has been no change in circumstances (for each partner, majority shareholder or substantial owner, as applicable), you may attach a copy of the previously completed affidavit(s) in lieu of completing a new one.

Detailed Instructions

Exemption Notice: Check appropriate box, as applicable, enter name of organization; and enter signature of authorized representative.

County of: Enter the name of the county where the affidavit is being acknowledged.

Contract No(s): Enter appropriate contract number(s), if applicable and if known.

Full Name of Affiant: Give the full legal name of the person making the affidavit.

Date of Birth: This is the date of birth of the affiant.

Social Security No.: Affiant's Social Security number.

Address: Enter the street, city, state and ZIP code where the affiant resides. Post office box numbers will not be accepted in lieu of the street address.

I certify that I: The affiant must check either **AM** or **AM NOT**, as appropriate, to make a true statement. If the affiant is **not** obligated to pay child support under a court order, then the next statement may be disregarded. Otherwise, it must be completed by checking the appropriate box.

Signature—Affiant: The full signature of the affiant (as it is entered in Full Name of Affiant at the top of the affidavit).

Date: Enter the date that the affiant signs the affidavit.

The affidavit must be acknowledged and notarized by a Notary Public. The date that the affidavit is acknowledged must be no earlier than 10 days before the date the bid is submitted or the application for the grant or loan is made, and no later than the date the bid is submitted or the application for the grant or loan is made. Failure to have the affidavit made and acknowledged within the dates indicated by this instruction will invalidate the affidavit.
