Get Crisis Counseling

Through the Texans Recovering Together program, Texas Health and Human Services partnered with providers in communities impacted by Hurricane Harvey to offer crisis counseling in homes and community settings.

Those free, anonymous and confidential services will no longer be available after Oct. 31, 2018.
