Medicaid Health Care Services:

All children and young adults age 20 and younger in managed care receive the same traditional Medicaid services. Some of those services are things such as:

Moms can learn about stages of pregnancy and ways to stay healthy. • \$100 gift card for pregnant members who attend a baby shower. • Members can get help to learn about breast-feeding and nutrition. • Birthing classes for pregnant members at certain sites. • \$20 gift card for new moms who attend a parenting class. • \$20 gift card for new moms who have a Home Visit. • \$30 gift card for Pregnant Members who download and register in the DHP Mobile Application. • \$20 gift card for completing a Pregnancy Health Risk Assessment. • One year of grocery delivery service for High-Risk Pregnant Members.

Space may be limited for some classes and offered on first come first serve basis. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Specialty services such as music therapy, art therapy, garden therapy and pet therapy are available one time per month per member. • Online social services resource directory is available on the Superior member website to locate community supports such as food and nutrition, housing, education, and employment services.
