Medicaid Health Care Services:

All children and young adults age 20 and younger in managed care receive the same traditional Medicaid services. Some of those services are things such as:

- Doctor and clinic visits
- 24-hour emergency care
- Hospital care
- Surgery
- Ambulance service
- Lab and X-ray services
- Major organ transplants
- Hearing tests and aids
- Home health services
- Community First Choice
- Personal Care Services
- Podiatrists (foot doctors)
- Help for drug or alcohol problems
- Dialysis for kidney problems
- Family planning services
- Eye checkups, glasses, and contact lenses
- Shots
- Texas Health Steps medical and dental checkups
- No limit on medicines Mental health services (such as counseling)
- Chiropractors (neck and back doctors)
- Private Duty Nursing

People on the MDCP waiver can receive the following services:

- Adaptive aids
- Minor home modifications
- Transition assistance services
- Employment assistance
- Flexible family support services
- Financial management services
- Respite services
- Supported employment

Extra Help Getting a Ride	Daily bus pass/token or cab fare for WIC offices, plan sponsored community events/classes or attend Member Advisory Groups meetings member's child(ren) who do not also have an appointment, as needed.	
Extra Vision Services	Fitting checkup and 20 percent off certain contact lenses and an additional \$100 above the existing benefit towards contact lens a year for members 12 years or older.	\$125 for eyeglasses frames/lenses or \$75 for contact lenses/fitting fees.
Discount Pharmacy / Over-the-Counter Benefits	Discount drug store services. Limited to \$25 per month per household.	
Sports and School Physicals		One sports/school physical in addition to a Texas Health Steps exam per calendar year to enrolled members ages 3 through 18.
Temporary phone help	Unlimited text messaging for members enrolled in the Federal Lifeline Program including free health education messages from Text4Babies, Text4Kids, and Text4Health.	
Help for Members with Asthma	Up to a \$100 per year incentive for enrolling in asthma disease management program.	
Healthy Play and Exercise Programs		Up to \$200 per member per enrollment year towards the enrollment of an accredited special health needs camp.
Gift Programs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> \$25 gift card after completing the STAR Kids Initial Screening and Assessment Process within 10 business days of enrollment. Notary services free of charge for STAR Kids members. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> \$25 incentive for members age 2 to 21 who complete an annual Texas Health Steps checkup. \$15 incentive per member for each Texas Health Steps exam completed. Texas Health Steps well visit must be completed on or within 45 days after the child reaches 2 weeks, 2 months, 4 months, 6 months, 9 months, 12 months, 15months, and 18 months of age. A one-time \$25 incentive for members age 6 to 12 newly diagnosed with ADHD who follow-up with a practitioner within 30 days after receiving the new medication. A one-time bathtub kneeling pad per household for CCHP Members ages 3 months to 3 years to prevent drowning during bathtime.
Respite Services	Up to an additional 10 hours in-home respite services for MDCP and coordinated care waiver members per month.

Inpatient Follow-Up Incentive Program	Free \$25 gift card for members who complete a follow-up visit with their doctor within 7 days of leaving the hospital.
