On September 30, 2017, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) received Texas MACPRO State Plan Amendment (SPA), Transmittal Number (TN) 17-0024, to reflect the state option to terminate Medicaid coverage for certain individuals who fail to meet the work requirements under Title IV-A of the Social Security Act (the Act). Specifically, §1931(b)(3)(A) of the Act gives states the option to terminate medical assistance (except for certain pregnant women and children) for individuals who fail to meet the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families work requirements.

Based on the information provided, we are pleased to inform you SPA 17-0024 was approved on December 13, 2017 with an effective date of August 1, 2017. The summary page (formerly CMS 179 form) as well as the approved reviewable units (formerly state plan pages) are now housed within the MACPRO system.
