

Mr. Smithers is 83 years old with dementia, and swallowing difficulty. He is a very slow eater and is fed in his room by staff. Recently his meal intake has decreased to an average of 75%. Mr. Smithers is 6'5" tall and currently weighs 146#. He has experienced a 30-pound weight loss since admission three years ago, and his Body Mass Index has decreased to 17kg/m². The Registered Dietitian calculated his daily energy needs as 1986 calories and 95 grams of protein. His serum albumin level has declined from 3.3 g/dL last quarter to 3.0 g/dL.
