You will get Medicaid in a different program:

You have been getting Medicaid in the program called, "Supplemental Security Income (SSI) Denied Children's Program." Due to federal law, this program is ending **December 31, 2013**. This program was created to be available for only a certain time period. That time period has ended.

Because that program ended, you will get Medicaid in a different program. We will send you another letter telling you more about your new Medicaid program.

Can you ask for a hearing to appeal if you don't agree with this action?

You can't ask for a hearing if you think this program you are in right now should not end -- it is ending due to a federal law. You can ask for a hearing if you think you should already be approved for benefits in another health-care program. To ask for a hearing, call 2-1-1 or 1-877-541-7905 (after you pick a language, press 2). You also can ask for a hearing by either sending us a letter or going to an HHSC benefits office near you. If you send a letter, include your: (1) full name, (2) case number, (3) address, and (4) phone number, if you have one. Mail the letter to: HHSC, PO Box 15100, Midland, TX 79711-9801.
