

ICD-10 Notification Due August 7, 2015

Please complete the spreadsheet as instructed below and return to Kim Davis at (kimberly.davis@hhsc.state.tx.us) no later than 5pm Friday, August 7, 2015. If you have any questions you may contact her by phone at (512) 462-6211 or at the above email address.

HHSC is assessing Texas' Medicaid and CHIP providers' ICD-10 readiness and is requesting your help to identify providers your health plan has contacted to conduct trader partner testing. HHSC acknowledges that many of the health plans are in the process of trader partner testing, therefore your response will not represent all of the providers that will have completed trader partner testing by October 1. However, your response in conjunction with TMHP's trader partner testing results will give HHSC a sense of providers' readiness at this point in time.

The attached spreadsheet that is to be returned to HHSC has three worksheets named:

- (1) [insert Health Plan Name];
- (2) TMHP Rural List; and
- (3) TMHP Top 50

Instructions for Completing the Spreadsheet

Worksheet 1 "Insert Health Plan Name":

- 1) Rename the worksheet with your health plan's name.
- 2) The providers listed should be representative of all of your health plan's line of business (STAR, STAR+PLUS, CHIP, etc.) and only listed once. For each provider that your health plan has contacted to conduct trader partner testing:
 - a. Enter each provider's National Provider Identifier (NPI);
 - b. Name of the provider's clearinghouse (if applicable);
 - c. Provider's name;
 - d. Trader Partner Testing Status - Choose from the drop down box: Completed, In Progress, Not Started, or Not Participating.

Worksheet 2 "TMHP Rural List" and Worksheet 3 "TMHP Top 50":

- 1) The providers listed on these worksheets are providers that have either not agreed to participate in TMHP's trader partner testing or have agreed, but have not started. HHSC will crosswalk these providers with those you list on Worksheet 1.
