

## ICD-9 to ICD-10 Crosswalk Document

In preparation for the ICD-10 transition, HHSC is sharing documentation detailing the diagnosis code mapping that Medicaid fee-for-service (FFS) will utilize for the ICD-9 to ICD-10 transition. The document includes service type information along with ICD-9 codes currently utilized in FFS claim adjudication and the corresponding ICD-10 codes. HHSC has worked with Accenture to create a more comprehensive document than what was provided in June, and has included here the specific ICD-9/ICD-10 procedure codes, as well as the correlating mapping document.

This information is being provided for ***informational purposes only*** so MCOs can have an understanding of what is being implemented to support FFS Medicaid claim adjudication post ICD-10 transition. If any of the code associations in the attached differ from your MCO's ICD-10 plan, you are not required to make changes to conform to the FFS mapping. However, MCOs should ensure that any variations from the FFS mapping are communicated to your network providers. These documents are not intended for publication on your website, or to be distributed to your providers; they should merely serve as an educational resource and internal guide.
