<b>1</b>	One-To-One Attendant Requirement	Allow for combined services so one attendant may provide services for more than one individual, i.e., in the instance of twins. Allow employment of one attendant at a time to provide services to more than one individual at \$14.00 per hour, resulting in a more qualified attendant.	Saving the state \$5.50 per hour, or, combined with attendant pay rate suggested in item #2, enables providers to utilize more attendant hours, offsetting the reductions recently imposed.	MDCP rules were revised to allow one attendant to serve more than one individual in the same household.	<b>Complete</b>
