

# DADS FYs 2016 and 2017 Performance Contract with a Local Intellectual and Developmental Disability Authority (LIDDA)

## EXECUTIVE OVERVIEW

The most notable changes to the FYs 2016 and 2017 Performance Contract are the addition of Attachment Q, which describes a LIDDA's responsibilities related to Community First Choice (CFC), and Attachment Y, which contains the requirements that were described in Attachment I from the amendment packet #6 of the FYs14-15 performance contract.

Other notable changes to the Performance Contract are as follows:

- All reference to "LA" have been changed to "LIDDA";
- the addition of four performance measures related to Preadmission Screening and Resident Review (PASRR); and
- the format of Form S has been changed from Microsoft Word to Microsoft Excel.

Key contract changes **from** the FYs 14-15 performance contract are noted below:

**Notification to Office of Inspector General (OIG)..... Article II. D. 48**

Requires the LIDDA promptly notify OIG of any suspected fraud, abuse or waste according to state or federal laws.

**LTSS Screen.....Article II. D. 49**

Requires the LIDDA to acknowledge the receipt of a referral in the LTSS portal.

**Performance Measures and Outcome Targets .....Attachment B**

Four new performance measures are added related to PASRR.

**Requirements Related to Individuals with IDD Residing in or Transferring from Nursing Facilities ..... Attachment G**

- Under I.A.3., the definition of "individual in the community" is changed to exclude individuals who transitioned from a nursing facility to an ICF/IID and the length of time after enrollment is changed to one year.
- Under II.C., the provision is revised to require submission of certain information into the Long Term Services online portal following an IDT meeting, rather than using form 1014.
- Under IV.H., the provision is revised to require certain activities for one year following an individual's enrollment into the HCS or TxHmL program.
- Under IV.I., language is added requiring certain activities for one year following an individual's enrollment into the ICF/IID program.

**Medicaid Program Enrollment Requirements .....Attachment K**

- Under II.N., the procedure for requesting an increase in the capacity of a LIDDA's HCS or TxHmL program is added.
- The section titled *Enrollment into Community First Choice (CFC)* is removed.

**Guidelines for Determining and Changing Designated LIDDA..... Attachment O**

Language is added regarding how to determine the designated LIDDA for individuals being assessed for, enrolling in, or enrolled in CFC provided through an MCO.

**Community First Choice..... Attachment Q**

This is a new attachment describing the requirements for a LIDDA relating to CFC services provided through an MCO.

**Enhanced Community Coordination Demonstration Project..... Attachment Y**

Attachment Y contains the requirements in the Enhanced Community Coordination Demonstration Project that were described in Attachment I from the amendment packet #6 of the FYs14-15 performance contract.

**Contact List..... Form S**

The form is an Excel document, rather than a Word document, and requires contacts for CFC.
