Hearing

HHSC will conduct a public hearing to receive comments regarding the proposed Medicaid rates detailed in this document on May 15, 2013, at 1:30 p.m. in the Brown Heatly Public Hearing Room, at 4900 North Lamar, Austin, TX 78751, with entrance through Security at the front of the building facing Lamar Boulevard. HHSC will consider concerns expressed at the hearing prior to final rate approval. This public hearing is held in compliance with the provisions of Human Resources Code §32.0282 and 1 TAC §355.105(g), which require a public hearing on proposed payment rates. 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Background

The Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) is responsible for the reimbursement determination for the Texas Medicaid Program. Proposed rates are calculated utilizing established methodologies that conform to the Social Security Act and related federal regulations, the federally approved Texas Medicaid State Plan, all applicable state statutes and rules, and other requirements.

The proposed rate is the result of a Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) directive for the State to become fully compliant with federal requirements at Title 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 483, Subpart C, governing the State's responsibility for preadmission screening and resident review of individuals with mental illness (MI) or an intellectual or developmental disability (IDD). The PASRR Level II evaluation determines if a person believed to have an MI or an IDD requires the level of care provided by a nursing facility (NF), and if so, whether they need specialized services for their MI or IDD.

Methodology

The specific administrative rules that govern the establishment of the fees in this proposal include this rule in Title 1 of the Texas Administrative Code (1 TAC):

- §355.748, which addresses reimbursement methodology for Preadmission Screening and Resident Review (PASRR) Level II Evaluation.
