**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED PAYMENT RATES FOR DAY ACTIVITY AND HEALTH SERVICES IN THE COMMUNITY BASED ALTERNATIVES AND MEDICALLY DEPENDENT CHILDREN PROGRAM**

**EFFECTIVE: September 1, 2012**

This document contains information relating to the proposed payment rates for Day Activity and Health Services (DAHS) in the Community Based Alternatives (CBA) and Medically Dependent Children (MDCP) waiver programs operated by the Department of Aging and Disability Services (DADS).

The Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) proposes to adopt rates for DAHS under the CBA and MDCP programs. The proposed rates will be effective September 1, 2012. The proposed rates are provided in Attachment 1.

The proposed rates were determined in accordance with the rate setting methodologies codified at 1 TAC §355.503, Reimbursement Methodology for the Community-Based Alternatives Waiver Program and the Integrated Care Management-Home and Community Support Services and Assisted Living/Residential Care Programs, and §355.507, Reimbursement Methodology for the Medically Dependent Children Program. Note that §355.503 and §355.507 will be proposed to be amended in the *Texas Register* to add a reimbursement methodology for DAHS to the CBA and MDCP waiver programs.

A public hearing will be held to receive public comments on the proposed rate at 1:00 p.m. on July 18, 2012, in the Lone Star Conference Room, of the Health and Human Services Commission, Braker Center, Building H, located at 11209 Metric Blvd, Austin, Texas. Entry is through Security at the main entrance of the building which faces Metric Boulevard. HHSC will consider concerns expressed at the hearing prior to final rate approval. This public hearing is held in compliance with the provisions of Human Resources Code §32.0282 and Title 1 of the Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §355.105(g), which require a public hearing on proposed payment rates.
