

ORDER

The parties in the above entitled and numbered civil action have filed a joint motion to modify the second sentence of paragraph 35 of the consent decree in this case. It appearing meritorious, the motion should be, and is hereby,

GRANTED. It is therefore

ORDERED that paragraph 35 is hereby amended accordingly, as follows:

“35. Beginning on September 1, 1995, outreach units will provide oral outreach to all recipients who miss a medial check up that is due on or after July 1, 1995.

“Due” means a medical check up that is due according to the current Texas EPSDT periodicity schedule, i.e., newborn, 1-2 weeks, 2 months, 4 months, 6 months, 9 months, 12 months, 15 months, 18 months, 24 months, 3 years, 4 years, 5 years, 6 years, 8 years, 10 years, and annually thereafter through and including

20 years of age.”
