NOTE 1: The incentives and disincentives are based on each MCO's timely checkup participation rate percentages. NOTE 2: The Total Incentives Paid column represents the available incentives paid and the disincentives recouped.

NOTE 3: Per the Primary Care Case Management contract, Texas Medicaid & Healthcare Partnership (TMHP) was paid as each report was submitted. The TMHP contract limits the total incentive amount TMHP can earn for the 2009 and 2010 State Fiscal Years to \$10 million. This limit was exceeded before all SFY 2010 reports were received. The Total Incentive Paid reflects the remaining amount paid to TMHP.

NOTE 4: UniCare Health Plans of Texas, Inc. (UniCare) and UnitedHealthcare-Texas (United) were not eligible to receive the incentives earned. UniCare's annual and quarterly checkup report resubmissions failed to reconcile with each other. United's annual checkup report resubmission did not validate, and the report failed to reconcile with United's quarterly checkup report resubmissions.
